Parent's Agreement

1. We understand that the doctrinal beliefs held by Crosspointe Baptist Church and Christian Academy will be taught in the school classrooms as they relate to all subjects as well as being taught in Bible classes. We have read the Student Handbook and the Financial Information Sheet and agree to abide by the policies set forth therein.
2. We realize that a Christian school is not a substitute for the training, fellowship, and discipline of the local church. Therefore, we agree to have our child in regular attendance in church where God's Word is preached, believed, and obeyed.
3. We grant permission to the school authorities to correct our child and to allow whatever corrective measures are necessary. We further agree to cooperate and discipline our child in the home according to the principles of Ephesians 6:4. We understand that any student is subject to review for dismissal by the administration at any time. If this is done or if our child is withdrawn, we realize that the current month's charges are due and payable and will not be refunded.
4. We have read the enclosed Statement of Faith.

- We believe that the Bible is the inspired Word of God, that there is one God, eternally existent in three persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.
- We believe in the deity of Christ; His virgin birth; His blood shed for man's atonement; His bodily resurrection; His ascension; His personal, pre-millennial, pre-tribulational coming for His redeemed ones; and His subsequent return to earth with His saints to establish His millennial kingdom.
- We believe all men are by nature sinful and lost and that for salvation, Holy Spirit regeneration is absolutely essential.
- We believe Satan is a person and Hell is a place of eternal, conscious punishment for all unsaved.
- We believe the Holy Spirit convicts of sin, makes believers children of God through the new birth, assures them of Heaven, and enables Christians to live a godly life by His indwelling. We believe that the gift of tongues ceased with the completion of the New Testament.
- We believe men are justified on the single ground of faith in the shed blood of Jesus Christ.
- We believe in the eternal security of the believer.
- We believe a New Testament Church is an organized body of baptized believers practicing Scriptural ordinances and actively engaged in fulfilling the Great Commission.
- We believe baptism is a Scriptural ordinance requiring the immersion of believers, and is only to be administered by a New Testament Church.
- We believe that marriage is solely between a man and a woman.
- We believe that God made mankind distinctly male and female.
- We believe the Lord's Supper is a Scriptural ordinance of the church to be partaken of by obedient Christians of like faith.
- We believe in the resurrection of both the saved and the lost; the saved unto the resurrection of life, and the lost unto the resurrection of damnation.
- We will not knowingly work together in any spiritual cause with the National Council of Churches, the World Council of Churches, or with those of the neo-orthodox, the neo-evangelical, the neo-pentecostal, the charismatic, or the ecumenical movements.

5. We give permission for our child to take part in all school activities, including sports and school-sponsored trips away from the school premises, and absolve the school from liability to us or our child because of any injury to our child at school or during any school activity.
6. We consider it a real privilege to have the opportunity to send our child to Crosspointe Christian Academy and shall endeavor to support and uphold the principles and practices and educational policies of the school in every way.
7. We realize that we as parents must maintain a proper attitude towards the school, its staff, and its policies. Though at times we may "agree to disagree" over some issue, we will not criticize the school, its staff, and its policies in front of our children or to other adults. We realize that failure to maintain this principle may result in the dismissal of our student.
8. We agree to uphold and support the high academic standards of Crosspointe Christian Academy by providing a place at home for our child to study and give our child encouragement in the completion of homework and assignments.
9. We recognize that for our child to make good progress in his work, it is essential that he have confidence in his teacher and school. Therefore, we will do all in our power to see that our child respects and obeys the school staff and rules. We agree that if our child should become involved in any difficulty with other children in the school, we will in no case complain to any parents, but with a prayerful Christian spirit will register only necessary complaints with the teacher or administration.
10. We will see to it that our child adheres to the dress code of Crosspointe Christian Academy.
11. We agree to pay the first tuition payment the first of July or August. We understand that the other nine or ten payments are due on or before the first day of the next nine or ten months, which are August or September through May; any account not paid in full by the tenth of each month will be assessed a \$30 late fee (per month); and that any child whose account is thirty days overdue will not be allowed to attend classes until the account is brought up to at least within 30 days of the current month.
